The ISAC Scholars program is designed to enhance the scientific and leadership experiences of emerging leaders in the field of cytometry. The ISAC Scholars program is designed for younger members, those under the age of 40. The program provides opportunities for leadership training, presentation opportunities, financial support for membership of the Society, as well as other valuable mentoring activities. Being chosen ISAC Scholar is an indication that you are recognized for your leadership potential, scientific skills and ability to achieve your career goals.

This five-year program provides Scholars with a complimentary membership in the Society, subscription to Cytometry Part A, the official Journal of ISAC, complimentary registration to CYTO and travel funds for the conference and possibly a one-time mentor training opportunity.

ISAC is seeking Scholars specializing in state of the art biomedicine, technology, and other areas of emerging sciences.

All Scholar applications are reviewed by an evaluation committee made up of the Membership Services Committee and other Society leaders who award the honor of being an ISAC Scholar to those of the highest caliber.

Five documents must be submitted:

1. This completed application form.
2. A full copy of your CV listing all of your publications, presentations, abstracts, honors and awards.
3. A letter from your supervisor or director, indicating your current status and the number of years you have been in that status (grad student, postdoc, junior faculty, technician, technologist, corporate position, etc).
4. A 2-4 page essay describing your goals as a scientist and how ISAC will assist in these goals.
5. A letter of reference from an ISAC member.

Submission Instructions:

To be named a 2013-2017 ISAC Scholar, you must make sure you application and supporting materials are received by January 15, 2013.
