- 3) Letter of Reference from a recent supervisor or director. The letter from your supervisor or director must indicate your current job status and the number of years you have been in that status. Letters can be uploaded during the application process or emailed to ldpapplications@isac-net.org.
- 4) Letter of reference from an ISAC member who is not your supervisor or director. Letters can be uploaded during the application process or emailed to ldpapplications@isac-net.org.
- 5) An essay (no more than 2 pages) describing your goals and how you can engage with ISAC during your time in the LDP and throughout your career.
